In Spetember 2018, Long Melford Church of England Primary School will celebrate it's second anniversary as an academy. The school is proud to be part of the Diocese of St Edmundsbury and Ipswich Multi-Academy Trust. The MAT is currently made up of a growing number of schools that work closely together sharing expertise and ensuring school improvement.

It has been a busy two year period for the Primary School:

- For the second year running the school looks to have exceeded national averages with some of our data. School data shows that our children are making good progress.
- We have developed our sports provision and have seen our teams have top three placings in most of the local competitions that they participated in. In July 2017 the school became the Suffolk County Swimming Champions. In June 2018 we came fourth in the County Tennis finals.
- We have had a number of trips including our residential trip to Norfolk in June for Year 6 children. In March the school participated in the Voice in a Million concert at Wembley with 2,500 members of school choirs. This was a fantastic experience for our children and their parents.
- We have developed our Nursery provision so that we can now offer places for mornings, afternoons and full days for pre-school children from the age of 3 years.
- We have opened Rainbow Club. This offers breakfast and after school support for our working parents through child care from 7.30 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. This is run by school staff and takes place every school day.
- In April 2018 we became part of the Suffolk Children's University.
- Through our close relationship with Holy Trinity Church, the first Messy Church session was held at school in March and was enjoyed by all who attended.
